- No Before Care
- Car Line begins.....10:15 am
- School begins.....10:30 am

EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Generally speaking, if school is closed for the entire day or in the case of an early dismissal due to inclement weather, all events, practices and activities in which students participate (regardless of where they take place) are canceled.

About Winter Weather Decisions

- Every attempt is made to make decisions to close or start school late prior to 5:30 am.
- Parent Alert text, voicemails, and emails are delivered within 20-25 minutes of a decision.
- It is important for Immanuel to have accurate primary contact information for all families. Please make sure your Immanuel Family Portal/ Family App Information is up to date.

Most Importantly – Be Prepared!

Please take time in advance of winter weather events to determine your individual plan for your children when Immanuel is closed, begins late, or is dismissed early.

Will school be online if we have to close? It will depend upon the number of inclement weather days used and time of year.

Will ILS offer childcare? If we have enough staff who can safely get to school, we will attempt to offer care. Our staff comes from all over the St. Louis/St. Charles area.
