Seasonal Weather Reminder:

As the weather gets colder to reflect the winter season, please remember, weather permitting, we will have recess outside.

Please be sure your child has weather appropriate clothing as they will not be allowed to stay indoors because they are cold.

When we do receive snow, only those children (JPS-6th grades) that have the appropriate snow clothes with them will be allowed to play in the snow (as per the handbook).

- Snow boots (recommended) or a second pair of shoes and socks to change into after recess,
- snow pants (recommended) or a pair of dry pants to change into after recess, gloves or mittens.
- Students may not wear snow boots during class time. Students must have a different pair of shoes to wear during class time on snowy days.
