**Pastor's Devotion**

*"Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name."* - John 20:30-31

We've all read parts of the Bible, we've heard it in chapel, maybe our parents read us scripture before going to bed, maybe we've studied it for religion class. Because of our familiarity with it, we know it is rare when the writer signals directly to the reader. Usually it tells a story, relates accounts, talks of a prophecy or life of Jesus, in a "historical record" manner.

But here, just after we hear of Jesus's death, resurrection, and Thomas's proper labeling Jesus as "My Lord and my God," the writer of the fourth Gospel turns to you, the reader, and tells YOU why he has been writing down the actions of Jesus: "...so that YOU may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing, YOU may have life in His name." The writer cares that YOU believe, YOU understand, so that YOU would have eternal life. He also is telling you that this is no myth nor folklore. Rather, this is the way in which the entirety of the story of scripture should be read: as true, and something to believe in!

Christ is risen, He is alive, He loves you, and by believing, YOU may have life in His name!
