Pastor's Devotion

This Lent, which is 40 days (not including Sundays), we are reviewing the six chief parts of the catechism: the Ten Commandments, the Apostles' Creed, the Lord's Prayer, the Sacrament of Holy Baptism, Confession, and the Sacrament of the Altar (the Lord's Supper, or Communion). I encourage you to pick up a copy of our Lenten Devotional, which is located in the Atrium of the church. It is a good review for all of us!

If you were at our midweek service this week, you would have heard about the moment when Jesus established the Lord's Supper. "Take and eat... take and drink..." Before the disciples even knew that Jesus was going to go to the cross, they heard believed these words, and after He ascended, they fully understood their mission as He had commanded them: Go, make disciples, baptize, and teach to obey His words. He followed that up with a promise to be with them always.

He gives that promise to us, too! He is always here. When you speak, He hears you. When you're happy, He rejoices with you. When you are sad, He knows how you feel. He was serious when He said He would be with us. He is also with us in the Lord's Supper! He does so in a unique way, bringing faith,

forgiveness, life, and community. What a great gift He continues to give! So remember Him, talk to Him, let Him be part of your every day. His love for you never ends!
