Next week, students in K-8th will take our MAP® Growth Assessments on a computer or tablet. MAP Growth is designed to measure how well a student is Tearning critical skills. It gives teachers detailed, actionable information they can use to quide instruction and better support students. It measures growth over the school year and across school years in math and reading (K 8th), reading fluency (K-3rd), and language arts (2nd-8th). It's okay to ask for help. Your teacher is there to guide you. Do the best you can rather than to be the first to finish.
