## MAP TESTING

Next week, students in K-8th will take our MAP® Growth Assessments on a computer or tablet. MAP Growth is designed to measure how well a student is learning critical skills. It gives teachers detailed, actionable information they can use to guide instruction and better support students. It measures growth over the school year and across school years in math and reading (K-8th), reading fluency (K-3rd), and language arts (2nd-8th). It's okay to ask for help. Your teacher is there to guide you. Do the best you can rather than to be the first to finish. # HANDBOOK SPOTLIGHT: DRESS CODE

Kindergarten - 8th grade

Please remember M-Th are required dress code days. Basic guidelines include: (*Fridays are spirit days*)

- Short or long sleeved collared shirts; preferred colors: red, black, grey, white.
- Appropriate sized shorts or pants in black or khaki preferred; navy, grey, plaid allowed (shorts - *minimum mid-thigh length*)
- Belts if belt loops on pants
- Girls may wear dresses or skirts but must have shorts, tights or leggings (no patterns) worn underneath
- Leggings/Jeggings are not pants and can not be worn as such

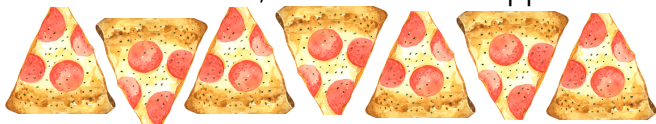
## Rally SUNDAY
