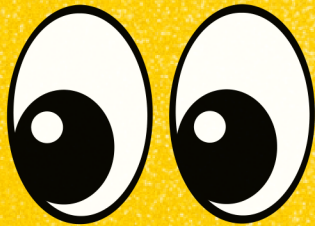
Anyone interested in this program will need to submit the application by Feb. 19, 2023. Approval of funds will be made by May 15, 2023.

## K-8 Tuition Assistance

**Step 1:** Complete application online through FACTS

- <https://online.factsmgmt.com/ga/inst-application/inst/4FG82>

**Step 2:** Submit payment for application (\$35)

**Step 3:** Submit **ALL** 2022 tax documents

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application

**Step 4: CHECK EMAIL**

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

### Required Documentation

- 2022—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2022 W2
- Business Income docs
  - ⇒ Schedule 1—5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
  - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

### Do You Qualify?

Families will qualify for some level of assistance from LESA if **at least 10% of income from 2022** is used to cover the cost of their child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition.

# Immanuel Art Fair Guidelines

**All students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 must submit an art project. (Preschool artwork can be entered for a participation ribbon only and will not be eligible at LHSN)**

## **Art Should Be Original**

Art submitted to the Art Festival should be an original work created by the student. Art assignments from class fall under this category as well as work done by the students on their own. Copies of famous Disney characters, cartoons from newspapers or comic books, coloring book pages, paint by number, or any other copyrighted image is not considered an original work and should not be included with the artwork submitted to the festival.

## **Art Should Reflect the Abilities of the Student**

The Art Festival provides a chance for students to display their work and their accomplishments. Parents and teachers are encouraged to become involved with the creative process but allow the student to make the actual product to be submitted.

## **Art Should be Properly Presented**

A piece of art can be enhanced by its presentation. Try to submit art that has been made with appropriate materials and matted or mounted on construction paper. Pencil, charcoal, pastel and other media that smudges should be sprayed with a fixative to prevent damage. Lined notebook paper should not be used for drawings and ragged edges from sketchbooks should be trimmed for a smooth look. Frames look nice but are heavy and difficult to hang. Three-dimensional work should be able to stand on its own or provide a method for display with instructions. Three-dimensional projects should be transported in a padded box or container to minimize the chance of breakage. Please label your container with the student name, school and grade.

## **Art Should Have Variety**

Try to submit work in a variety of media. Acceptable 2-dimensional media includes pencil, charcoal, crayon, ink and ink wash, watercolor, acrylic and oil paint, chalk, pastel, original photography, collage, screen prints and linoleum prints or any combination of the above. Acceptable 3-dimensional media includes ceramic, plaster, wood, metal, paper and cardboard sculptures.

## **Other Information**

All artwork is due Monday, February 13, 2023. The students should bring their projects to the Atrium by 8:30AM. Projects will be on display through Friday, February 17, 2023. Projects will not be awarded ribbons until Friday morning, after all judging is complete. All projects need to be taken home on Friday, February 17, 2023. Only projects that receive a blue ribbon will go on to the Lutheran High School North Academic Fair. The date for dropping off projects is TBD and we will let you know closer to the art fair date.
